Enrollment Packet 2021-2022

Registration takes place according to the following priority:

1. Returning Students and Siblings of Currently Enrolled Students (March 15- March 19)
2. Alumni Families (March 22-26)
3. New Families (March 29 - until all spots are filled)

You must submit your **complete** registration packet and a non-refundable \$50 registration fee in order to secure a spot for the 2021-2022 school year. Packets (and checks) can be submitted at WPNS between 8:15-11:30 Monday through Friday. Alumni Families have first priority the first two weeks. Registration will continue until both classes are full.

New enrollees meet the following age requirement by September 1st:

- 3 years old for Tuesday/Thursday Program
- 4 years old for the Monday/Wednesday/Friday program

Children meeting the following age requirements by September 1st may enroll if space is permitted and at the discretion of the Director/Board:

- 2 years, 9 months for Tuesday/Thursday program
- 3 years, 9 months for Monday/Wednesday/Friday program
- 2 years, 8 months and younger-Discretion of Direction

****All immunizations must be up to date and submitted to the school before your child may begin class. The new California law requires all students attending school in California to be current in immunizations in order to start school. We advise you to schedule an appointment with your child's pediatrician as soon as possible and check to be sure your child is not behind in immunizations. Personal and religious beliefs are no longer accepted. The following immunizations are required for school entry:**

3 doses of Polio

4 doses of DTaP

1 dose of MMR

1 dose of Hib

3 doses of Hep B

1 dose of Varicella

Membership and Tuition Overview

All families are required to work in the classroom at least once a month. In both our Tuesday/Thursday and Mon/Wed/Fri Program we offer an AM Class (8:30-11:00am) and a PM Class (12:00-2:30pm). Tuition is as follows:

Tuesday/Thursday Program: \$185.00/month

Mon/Wed/Fri Program: \$250.00/month

Note: A 10% tuition discount is given to families having two or more children enrolled.

A one-time supply and portfolio fee of \$75.00 per child is due with the first month's tuition.

WPNS Cooperative Parent Commitment

- Work in the classroom once a month from 8:15/11:45 until all duties are completed (usually around 12 or 2:45 depending on class). If you are unable to work on your assigned workday, you must TRADE days with another working parent, provide a substitute or pay a \$40 fine.
- Hold a job or board position. Average time commitment is 3-4 hours per month.
- Actively participate in Children's Festival efforts or pay a buyout fee of \$350.00.
- Sell the minimum number of raffle tickets required by the fundraising committee.
- Participate in one group workday to clean the school. Workdays are approximately four hours and are on the weekends.
- Abide by all policies and procedures of WPNS as stated in the Parent Handbook (available on website).
